What could the Institute help with? What already exists? What deserves a careful next step?

Why meet?

People can be surrounded by programs, offices, reports, and services and still lack a clear path through a difficult situation. The Institute develops maintained guides, tools, standards, and handoff practices for that gap. A conversation should begin by finding existing work, naming the responsible authority, and deciding whether the Institute should improve, connect, test, transfer, pause, or stop.
